### **Authority/Directive to write NARP**

- DOD Directive 3150.8, June 13, 1996 (DOD Response to Nuclear Weapon Accidents and Incidents)
  - "Commanders of the Unified Combatant Commands shall ...
    - Direct and coordinate the DoD response actions."
    - Conduct a Response Task Force (RTF) exercise at least once annually"
- Draft Change to DOD 3150.8
  - "Commander, US Northern Command shall direct the response for nuclear weapons accidents and incidents occurring within the USNORTHCOM Area of Responsibility"
- DoD 3150.8-M (NARP), 22 Feb 2005
  - CDR USNORTHCOM has primary responsibility to Execute DoD response to Nuclear Weapon Accident in the USNORTHCOM AOR, if the weapon was in DoD custody at the time of the accident



### **NARP CONOPS**

- NARP CONOPS briefed to USNORTHCOM Commander's Executive Board Jun 04 and DCDRUSNORTHCOM Oct 04
- COA selected by NC/J3 USNORTHCOM has OPCON of Service IRF and RTF
- Seek CDRUSNORTHCOM approval through staffing of Draft USNORTHCOM NARP



### NARP Sequence of Events


### Weapon in DoD custody in NC AOR

- OPREP-3 BROKEN ARROW Notification to NMCC
- NMCC notifies White House, SECDEF etc. & convenes conference call with Ops Centers of USNORTHCOM, Services, JFCOM, DTRA, DHS, FEMA, DOS, DOE, DOJ (FBI), etc.
- NMCC dispatches a Service IRF (Immediate Lifesaving, security & safety controls at accident site)
- Service RTF alerted and deployed
- NMCC gives OPCON of responding forces to USNORTHCOM
- RTF Commander Is On-Scene CDR (OSC) and reports OPCON to USNORTHCOM
